Problematic sexual behaviour remains a highly controversial and poorly understood phenomenon among many educators, counsellors, social workers and mental health practitioners. This seminar will provide participants with an overview of the major schools of thought related to understanding out of control sexual behaviour, as well as an introduction to relevant assessment strategies and intervention modalities.

At the end of this seminar participants will be able to:

- 1) identify at least three models related to the aetiology and treatment of problematic sexual behaviours;
- 2) identify substance use and behavioural problems that often co-occur with problematic sexual behaviours;
- 3) develop the basic skills needed for conducting a bio-psycho-sexual history; identify how clinician biases can lead to both over, and under, diagnosis of problematic sexual behaviour.

He is currently in private practice where he works with individuals, couples, and families presenting with a variety of sexual, chemical dependency, and trauma related, concerns and issues.
